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Jim Spatola and Jeff Williamson Named to Performance Food Group Executive Team

In his new role, Williamson will oversee PFG's facilities, construction, inbound logistics, outbound transportation and warehouse functions. He will work closely with operations leaders in PFG divisions to drive and sustain operational excellence throughout the company.

Williamson joined PFG in 2003 as Director of Warehouse Methods and Industrial Engineering. He was promoted to Vice President of Warehouse Operations before being named Senior Vice President of Operations for Performance Foodservice in 2008, his most recent position.

Prior to joining PFG, Williamson served as Senior Manager, Distribution Systems & Process for US Foods from 1996 to 2003. He previously held industrial engineering positions with McClier, an architectural/engineering firm, and Standard Register.

Williamson earned a bachelor's degree in industrial engineering from the University of Illinois.
